



## Garlinge Primary School and Nursery

### Nursery Admissions Policy

#### For children entering Nursery (the term after a child's third birthday)

Garlinge Primary School and Nursery are responsible for the admission arrangements of their nursery. Parents are able to obtain information about the process from the school office.

Children are admitted on the same basis as Kent County Council's Admissions "entry into year R" admissions criteria. *Please see details below and for full details see Admissions Policy for children entering Year R (the year of a child's 5<sup>th</sup> birthday).*

#### **Determined Oversubscription Criteria for Garlinge Primary School and Nursery (co-education community school):**

- Children in Local Authority Care or Previously in Local Authority Care
- Current Family Association
- Health and Special Access Reasons
- Nearness of children's homes to school

Children start Nursery the following term after their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday.

Parents whose children are offered places will be sent a letter inviting them to school to meet with Nursery Teacher.

At the time of meeting:

- Teacher will meet and greet the family
- Show them the Nursery and get to know your child and parents
- Ask what session the parent would like and how many days a week

#### **Nursery sessions are:**

**Mornings 8:45am to 11:45am**

**Afternoons 12:30pm to 3:30pm**

- Children are funded for up to 15 hours a week by the Local Authority.
- Does your child have medical/SEN needs
- Entrance forms will be given for parents to complete and return to the school office with their child's birth certificate and evidence of where they live.
